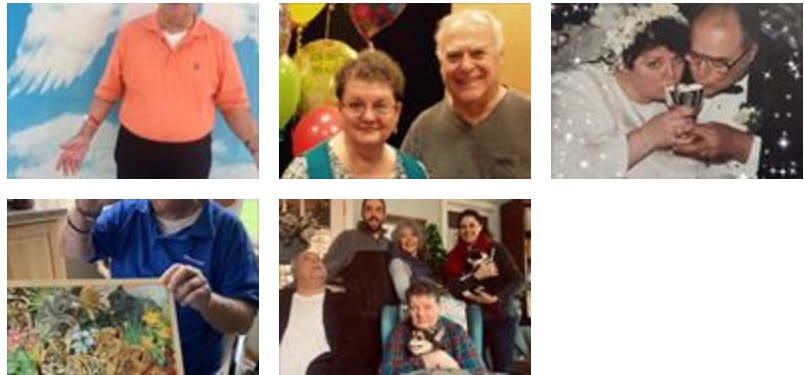


*So sorry for your loss Carollynne! So happy Tony lived his last years happy with you.

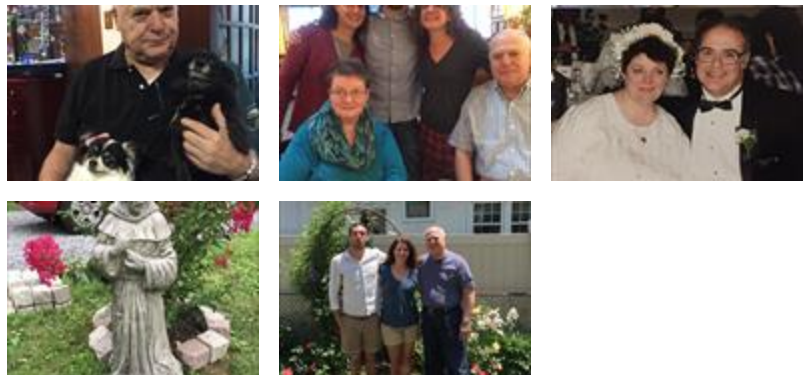
