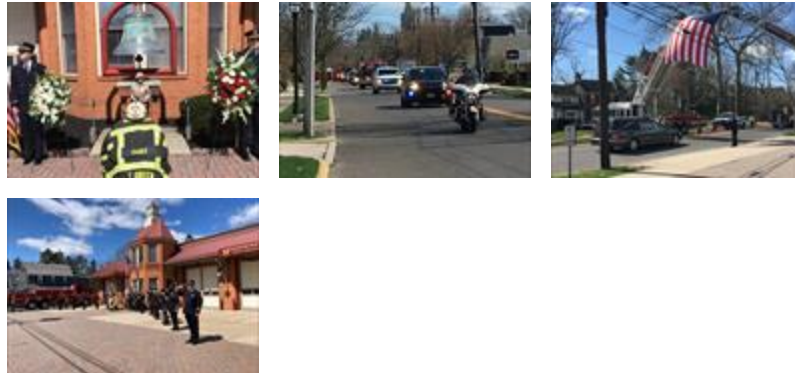

I had no idea what a pike pole was. So I'm standing next to 3121 looking for this thing. Up runs this 17 year old kid named Tony asking me what I was looking for. I told him and he told me that all the pike poles on this truck were already taken. So, he runs down the block to 3111, which was at the hydrant, grabs a pike pole and runs it back to me in front of the building.
