Beverley Anne Davies Kolb, a resident of Moorestown, NJ, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her family, on December 20, 2020. Beverley was born in Forty-Fort, Pennsylvania on March 27, 1926. She was the daughter of Wesley Evans Davies and Gertrude Mary Gordon Davies from Kingston and Shavertown, Pennsylvania.

Beverley attended Wyoming Seminary (high school) where she played Varsity Field Hockey. She received her BS from Drexel's College of Home Economics. She was employed by Drexel as a Dietician in their cafeteria, when she met her future husband, John (Jack) Kolb. Beverley also served as an Assistant Professor of Dietetics and Food Management in the Drexel College of Home Economics, and was a registered ADA Dietician.
