In addition to serving as State Regent of the New Jersey State Society Daughters of the American Revolution, she also served as a national vice chairman. She served as the State President and a national officer of the Daughters of Founders and Patriots of America. She was a past president of the Rancocas Valley Chapter Colonial Dames XVII Century, and served as a state officer. She was a member of the U.S. Daughters of 1812, Colonial Dames of America, Sons and Daughters of the Pilgrims, Descendants of Washington's Army at Valley Forge, as well as several other organizations.

Carole was an avid genealogist tracing various branches of her family tree back many generations. A true patriot who loved this great Republic, she was proud to have proved direct lineage to more than eleven (11) patriots who gave service in the Revolutionary War. [SEP]

As a member of the First United Methodist Church of Moorestown for over 40 years, she served God by teaching Sunday School for many years, being Sunday School coordinator for a few years, and running a women's Bible study for many years. She was a Girl Scout Troop Leader and Cub Scout Den Mother for many years as well. Together with her daily, her involvement in community service projects was endless and all projects focused on children, veterans, active duty military and their families, and those less fortunate. Her family will continue the same efforts so her legacy will continue.
