Catherine W. "Kit" Bremble, died on April 16, 2025. She was 96. Kit was pre-deceased by her husband, John A. Bremble, Jr., her brother and her fiancé, E. J. Neal Hedger. She had no survivors. Kit, whose parents were Alfred and Lillian Whisler, was born, raised and educated in the Philadelphia area and attended Beaver College (now known as Arcadia). Even after her move to Moorestown in her later years, her heart remained in Philadelphia, and she frequently crossed the river to enjoy Philadelphia's many historic sites.

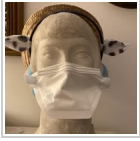
