Chris graduated from Eastern Bible College with a BA and from Drexel University with a Masters in Library Science. Upon graduation, he went to work at the Moorestown Library where he retired after 30 plus years' service. Chris was involved in many historical societies as well as having an avid interest in his English roots making many trips to England over the years. While there, he would visit his college roommate and lifelong friend. He also was a member of the Moorestown meeting and later the Mt. Holly meeting. He became certified in the state of New Jersey to teach, helping out at the Moorestown Friends School for a number of years after his retirement. He spent about the last 20 years as a part of the Medford Leas community, where he spent time participating in many committees and helping in their library. Until his recent decline, he also was a fixture at the Coffee Shop where he had lunch most days.
