Christine Allen, 93, a long-time resident of Moorestown, passed away on Wednesday, August 27, 2014.

She was born in Philadelphia on November 30, 1920, to the late Edith and Isaac Luther Schaffer. Christine took classes at Peirce School of Business Administration (currently known as Peirce College), and married the late Walter Allen in 1938.

Christine and Walter purchased a 30-acre farm in Moorestown in 1942, known then as Sunset Farm. The Allen family raised chickens among other livestock, and traveled by horse-drawn cart to deliver fresh eggs to their neighbors.

Christine had an affinity for dogs, particularly German Shepherd Dogs, which she bred and showed competitively. In 1956, Christine opened Allen's Kennel, a boarding kennel for dogs and cats, still a Moorestown institution to this day.

Christine was an avid quilter, and had a deft hand at many knitting and sewing crafts. She and Walter loved to travel, and together they saw nearly every state in the union.

Christine is survived by two children: Dorothy Allen and Robert Allen, both of Moorestown, who operate businesses on the family farm, currently known as

Woodedge. She is also survived by five grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Christine was predeceased by one sibling: her sister, Dorothy Schaeffer, of Los Alamos, NM.

Christine will be memorialized in a private gathering for family members.
