Dale R. Collins, 70, passed away on September 9, 2025, of Moorestown, New Jersey. Born on December 5, 1954, in Mt. Holly, New Jersey, Dale lived a life marked by dedication to his family and professional pursuits. He was a devout Christian who had a natural bent to theology and teaching. With his wife, Joy, he home schooled their children.

Dale earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Physics from Montclair State College, laying the foundation for a career defined by precision and innovation. He went on to work at Lockheed Martin in Moorestown for 15 years, contributing his skills and knowledge to one of the nation's leading aerospace and defense companies.
