Deanna was born in Camden NJ on 12/26/1937. She met her husband, William, as a young teenager and it was a love affair that lasted 58 years. She was first and foremost a person who was devoted to her family as a wife and mother. After raising three children, she went back to school at age 36 to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences from Temple University. She became the Director of Medical Records at Temple University and subsequently at Pennsylvania Hospital. Her skills as an administrator helped advance the medical records profession at a time when it was entering the computer age. She cared deeply for her employees and helped to mentor several on their career paths. She became ill with liver cancer in 1993 and her career abruptly ended. She battled cancer since that time but never let this define her life. She was a dynamic and active person and she went on to become a master quilter and a member of the Lady Bugs Quilting group and Moorestown Quilting Guild. She was also a member of the Historical Society of Moorestown. She was a wonderful planner and organizer and her family enjoyed many vacations and trips with her over these years.

Deanna is survived by her loving husband William, her children William (Patricia), Patricia Barbour (Jamie) and Robert (Maureen). She is also

survived by seven grandchildren who she loves dearly: William (Barbara), Mollie (Andrew), Mallory, Katherine, George, Dan and John.
