



## Donald Sikora

Donald Stephen Sikora, aged 96, passed away on September 28, 2024, in Burlington Township, NJ. Born on March 4, 1928, he dedicated many years to his career as an electrical engineer, notably with RCA in Moorestown, NJ, and Dupont in Wilmington, DE. Donald proudly served in the US Navy Reserve from 1945 to 1947, demonstrating a commitment to duty that carried over into his professional and personal life. He received his bachelor's degree from New Jersey Institute of Technology, which laid the foundation for his successful engineering career.

A man of faith, Donald was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Moorestown for 65 years. His hobbies included sailing and woodworking, activities that reflected his love for precision and the outdoors.

Donald was preceded in death by his wife, Elinor R. Sikora. He is survived by his son, David N. Sikora and wife Barbara; daughter Ruth E. Seel and her husband Marshall; and grandchildren Carly Sikora, Stephen Sikora, Kristen Folsom, Kelly Piccari, Molly Seel and 8 great-grandchildren.

Interment will be private.

A memorial service will be held on October 9, 2024, at 11:30 am at The Masonic Village of Burlington, 902 Jacksonville Rd, Burlington, NJ.
