James J. Florio, age 85, passed away peacefully on September 25, 2022, surrounded by his family. Governor Florio served in the US Navy for 20 years achieving the rank of Lt. Commander. He served as the Governor of New Jersey from 1990–1994 and served in the U.S. House of Representatives from 1975-1990. He also served in the NJ Assembly from 1969-1975. Most recently, he was a working Founding Partner in the law firm of Florio Perrucci Steinhardt Cappelli Tipton & Taylor LLC. He is survived by his wife of 34 years, Lucinda (nee Coleman), his children Christopher (Helen) Florio, Gregory (Ann) Florio, Catherine (Marc) Pipas, and stepson, Mark (Michelle) Rowe; grandfather to Matthew, Chelsea, Alexandra, Elizabeth and Peter Florio; Victoria and Stephanie Pipas; Jack, Troy and Bret Rowe; and great grandfather to Esmé and Bodhi Florio. Brother of Richard (Sheila) Florio and the late William Florio. Also survived by his former wife Maryanne Florio.

Following Governor Florio's wishes, a private interment will be held. 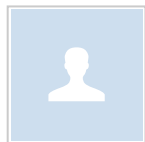

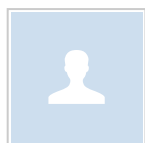
