Jane Renee Titus Ackerson Cleaver, age 93, died Friday morning May 6th, 2022 at the Wiley Christian Retirement Community in Marlton, New Jersey. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert E. Cleaver, on April. 19, 2015. They were married for 62 years.

Born in Brooklyn, N.Y. in 1929, she was the daughter of the late Alfred H. and Edna Pope Ackerson. Jane grew up in Forty Fort, PA and was a graduate of the Wilkes-Barre Day School and Fairfax Hall of Waynesboro, VA.

Prior to her retirement, she worked for Sears Roebucks for over 20 years.

She was an active member in the Moorestown Monthly Meeting, working as the Meeting Secretary, Clerk of the Meeting and in various other capacities over the years.

Jane remained active her entire life. She loved music, especially country music, playing the piano and doing a variety of arts and crafts. She practiced

yoga before it was widely popular and participated in community theater, which is where she and her husband first met. In her later years she particularly enjoyed painting and always looked forward to a friendly conversation.
