Blessed Memory ! Jean Ann Romanoff (nee Wozniak), on July 29, 2022, age 78, of Moorestown, NJ.

Born in Passaic, NJ to Stanley and Helen Dombrowski Wozniak, Jean studied nursing at the Jersey City Medical Center, where she would meet the love of her life and future husband, Nicholas. She subsequently continued her nursing profession at Baylor University Hospital, Houston, TX.

Jean was the beloved wife of Dr. Nicholas Romanoff for 58 years. She was the cherished mother of four beautiful daughters who she lovingly called her "4 C's": Catherine Romanoff LaGrua (Daniel LaGrua), Christine Romanoff, Casey Romanoff Coffin (Shannen Coffin), and Caryn Jeanne Romanoff Giannini (Lorenzo Giannini).

She was the devoted grandmother of eight, who affectionately called her "Jay": Cayleigh and Nicholas LaGrua; Alexander, Abigail, and Anastasia Morris; and Caroline Jean, Brendan, and Declan Coffin.

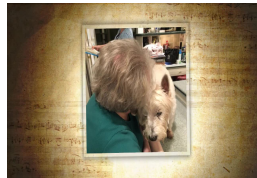
