John L. Wilmot, 86 “ Jack” a life-long resident of Moorestown, NJ passed away December 5, 2017. He was born to Claire Haines Wilmot and John L. Wilmot on April 13, 1931 in Philadelphia, PA. Jack was preceded in death by his sister, Jean H. Wilmot. Jack graduated from Our Lady of Good Counsel School, Moorestown High School and Gettysburg College.

From the age of 14, Jack dreamed of flying. He fulfilled his dream by becoming a fighter pilot in the U.S. Air Force and served at the end of the Korean War. In early 1963, Jack was hired by TWA, doing what he loved, flying until his retirement in 1992. Jack was an avid reader, had a passion for travel, loved sports, and enjoyed spending time with family, especially watching his grandchildren participate in sports.

Jack is survived by his wife of 61 years, Stella, daughter, Claire W. Kraft and her husband, Canning, of Alexandria, VA and son, Stephen J. Wilmot and his wife, Dene, of Hilton Head Island, SC and his grandchildren, Courtney Perry (Chris), C.K. Kraft, III, Charlie Wilmot and Ashley Wilmot.
