Eysmans, Julien Lycurgue, III . On April 3, 2015 age 87 of Medford Leas. Julien was born in New York City on June 23, 1927. He attended various schools, and got his Bachelor's degree from Hobart College. After serving in the Marine Corps, he worked for the Pennsylvania Railroad, and in the Trust Department at the First Pennsylvania Bank, retiring in 1987.

Julien met his wife Mary (Geer) in 1948, and they were married in 1949. They settled in Moorestown in the 1960's, raising three children – Tom, Margaret, and Jule - and were active in the Trinity Church community. He was a charter member of Burlington County CONTACT. After Julien retired, they moved to Johnson City, Tennessee where they lived for ten years. They returned to New Jersey in 2000 and moved onto the Lumberton campus of the Medford Leas retirement community. Mary died in 2005, and Julien moved to the Medford campus in 2009.

Julien's interests included sailing, traveling by motor home and with Elderhostel, and flying (though never soloing). He was also active in the Medford Leas community. He was never one to cling to the past, but was always willing to move into the next stage of his life. He had truly found a home in Medford Leas.

Besides his children, Julien had a daughter-in-law, Tom's wife Sheila Denion, four grandchildren - Emory Shediack, Courtney Steiert (husband Will), Seth Eysmans (wife Cristin) and Cabell Eysmans, and five great-grandchildren – Carter, Jackson and Hannah Steiert, and Alexander and Scarlett Eysmans.
