LaVonne T. Camp, on November 13, 2022 at home, surrounded by her family, at the age of 99. Vonnie has been a resident of Moorestown for 55 years. She was born in Carbondale, Pa. to Herbert Lee Telshaw and Henrietta (nee Rogers) Telshaw. She graduated from Waymart High School in Waymart, Pa. in 1940 and subsequently attended Moses Taylor Hospital School of Nursing in Scranton, Pa. obtaining her RN in 1943. She joined the Army Nurse Corps. in 1944, serving in the 14th evacuation hospital and other duty stations in the China-Burma-Indian theater of WWII .

After the war she married, Arthur William Camp, a pilot she met during her time in Burma. LaVonne is survived by her three children, Ann Camp, of Guilford, CT; Arthur W. Camp, Jr. of Moorestown, NJ; and Peter James Camp of Boynton Beach, FL; and her granddaughter, Caitlin Bryn Allen of Durham, NC.

A graveside service will be held in the spring at the Presbyterian Cemetery in Moorestown, NJ.
