Baumer, Leon N. On Feb. 11, 2014 age 93 of Moorestown, NJ formerly of

Sylvania, OH. Leon was born in Kendall, NY. During WWII he served as a

navigator in the US 8th Air force, 491st Heavy Bombardment Unit. He was

awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for “courage, coolness and exceptional

skill”. After the war he attended Alfred University in NY where he majored in

ceramic engineering. He worked as a ceramic engineer at both Mellon Institute in

Pittsburgh, PA, and Owens Illinois in Perrysburg, Ohio in their industrial research

and development groups, retiring in 1985. Leon was husband of the late Jean (nee

Mahaffey), and is survived by his daughter Carol (Frank) Manion of

Moorestown, and his grandchildren Ryan F. & Erica M. Manion. Memorial
