It is with great sadness that we share that Lisa Ann Mrak died suddenly in Newark, DE on January 4, 2024. She was born in Philadelphia, Pa on January 4, 1954. She was a loving wife to Tony Mrak, wonderful daughter to her predeceased parents, Phil and Carolyn Piro, caring sister to Phil (Marion), Steve(Linda), Michael, Mark(Amy), Paul (Jane) and Carolyn, sister-in-law to Carole (Bob) and Linda (Brady) and a thoughtful aunt and great aunt to nearly 20 nieces and nephews.

She spent her early years in Erial, NJ and Los Angeles, CA before moving to Moorestown, NJ with her parents and siblings. She graduated from Moorestown HS in 1972 and moved to DC, graduating in 1974 from Marymount University with a degree in Fashion Design.
