Lois Priscilla (Johnson) Bryan passed away at age 65 in Burlington, N.C., this February. Priscilla was born in Camden on 8/6/1954, the daughter of the late Frederick A. Johnson and the late Edith R. (Hartman) Johnson. She was predeceased in death by her husband Ken M. Bryan. Priscilla attended First United Methodist Church of Moorestown in her youth. She graduated from Moorestown H.S. in 1972 and received a b.a. from Lebanon Valley College in 1976. More recently she played at the Senior Center in Burlington, NC.

Priscilla created a number of craft projects through the years, projects that frequently reflected her Christian faith as well as her love for the Jersey Shore. She started a dating service and prayed over the matches she made. Some of the couples she matched up wound up getting married. Priscilla was always generous and concerned for other people despite numerous health problems.
