Louis Arthur North, 89, of Cinnaminson, NJ died peacefully at home on September 21st, 2016.

He was pre-deceased by his wife of 55 years, Ann Carey North. He is survived by his sons CDR Louis A. North, Jr., USN (retired) and his wife Rachel, of Alexandria, VA; Robert V. North, and his wife Leslie of Great Falls, VA; Thomas M. North, and his wife Laura, of Harrison Township, NJ; stepdaughters Helen Skelly and husband John, of Lyme, NH; Sally Hartman and husband Robert, of Moorestown; and stepson Stanley Druckenmiller and wife Fiona of New York City; seven grandchildren, and eight step-grandchildren.

He was born in Philadelphia to Louis A. and Virginia M. North, and was raised in Woodbury, NJ where he graduated from Woodbury High School in 1945. He has lived most of the last 55 years as a resident of Moorestown and Cinnaminson, and spent many winters at his home in Florida.

He served in the US Army in the 202nd Military Police Company during the occupation of Vienna, Austria at the end of World War II. After his military service he attended Lafayette College where he received a BS in Civil Engineering, and later received a Masters Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Pennsylvania. He worked for several engineering firms over his career, most notably as a partner in the Philadelphia firm of CSE Associates for over 27 years. He and his firm designed the steel frames and foundations for many high rises and bridges along the east coast.

He and wife Ann were passionate golfers and skiers, and did both well into their seventies. He was a longtime member of The Moorestown Field Club, where he served on the board of directors for many terms. He was also a member and Chairman of the City of Moorestown Planning Board.

Lou will be greatly missed by his family and friends. A remembrance and celebration of his life will be held at The Moorestown Field Club, 629 Chester Avenue, Moorestown, NJ, on November 5th, 2016 from 1-4 PM.
