Marjorie F. Davis (Freer), 83, passed away on August 12, 2016, in Moorestown, NJ.

Marjorie was born on March 9, 1933 in Honesdale, PA, to William and Anna Freer. She spent her childhood in Johnson City and Mt. Upton, NY. She married John Arthur Davis, Jr. and they raised their children on the family dairy farm in Wells Bridge, NY.

Marjorie pursued a career in real estate, which through her dedication and expertise, grew into one of the largest farm and land real estate agencies in the Southern Tier of Upstate New York. Over the years, she achieved many educational and professional accomplishments and accolades, among which were GRI, Graduate, Realtor Institute, from Cornell University and numerous awards for the high quality of her work and dedication that she delivered to her clients, including Realtor of The Year designations. Her later years of life were spent in Zephyrhills, FL, where she devoted herself to charitable work with the local Rotary Club and "Guardian ad Litem" Program.
