Upon getting married, she moved “down south” to Deptford and spent the next six decades living in Gloucester County. Shortly after her move, she got a part-time job washing pots at Deptford High School. Over time she was promoted to different positions until she ended up running the entire Deptford School System’s Food Services Program. As if this wasn’t enough to keep her busy, during her time in Deptford she was a member of the PTA, volunteered in the school library, was Chair of the Women’s Auxiliary, ran the concessions stand for the little league, was a Cub Scout Den Mother, knocked on doors to garner support for political candidates, and cooked spaghetti dinners for the entire Deptford High School football team each Friday night during the season.

Summers were Mary’s time to relax. She loved spending the day on the beach in Ocean City with her family and her friend Vicky Hansen. She also was grateful for time with her dog Precious.

Mary, known as Bunny to her family, is survived by her beloved son Frank, daughter-in-law Mindy, and grandchildren Ashley, Brad and Joe. She is also survived by her niece Ginny Straiges (Bob) and her niece Jean Schmidt, who was a wonderful friend and took loving care of her in her final days.
