



## Nancy Choate

December 16, 1934 - January 24, 2023

Nancy Choate (nee Scimia) died peacefully on January 24, 2023 at the age of 88 with her family at her side. Nancy was born and raised in Oakfield, New York. For the past four years, Nancy resided at the Moorestown Evergreens, where she lived with Dale, her high school sweetheart and husband of 64 years. She spent the last 39 years as a Moorestown, New Jersey resident, during which time she enjoyed golfing, tennis, bowling, socializing, and directing and performing in local charity and other shows. Her crowning glory was the Moorestown Field Club's 100th Anniversary variety show. Nancy graduated from Cortland State with a degree in Early Education. Early in her married life, Nancy taught elementary school in Western New York before leaving her career to raise her three daughters. The family moved often in the early years, and Nancy joined many organizations, including newcomers and the PTA, and made many friends in each new town. Nancy and Dale's retirement years were shared between Moorestown and Florida. Nancy is survived by her husband Dale Choate, and her three daughters, Debbie Choate (Tom Rissman), Suzanne Debs (Jeffrey) and Karen Mead (Brett). She is also survived by her brother Leo Scimia (Betty), her sister Ada Glowacki, and her 6 grandchildren, Lauren, Kelly, Lyndsay, Julie, Jonathan and Tyler.
