I recall vividly on my first rotation in nursing school, 1978, you said to me, "you are a nurturer by nature, but you need to learn to nurture yourself." As time passed, I graduated, you came to me on the rehab unit at Jefferson and bestowed the greatest compliment upon me, asking if I would come with you to see your mother who had had a stroke and desperately needed rehab nursing care planning and intervention, you asked would I help? It was an honor. Several years later I tracked you down and called you at St. Agnes where you were the Director of Nurses. I, in tears, told you of a tragic death intra partum of baby who should not have died in a maternity until where I was then employed. You, you offered me a job, on the spot...I was shocked, talked and accepted the position you so graciously offered. Tonight, it is 37 years later and you are so on my mind. I searched for you on Facebook, pondered your age as I now sit at near 64 and after much online searching found you have left us. I am so very sorry our paths did not pass again in this journey we call life. You taught me so much and I owe you so very much for the preparation you gave me for a journey that has not been easy, but has been multiply blessed.
