Ralph Albert Hannmann, Jr. of Moorestown, N.J. died peacefully on Tuesday, February 10th. Ralph was the owner of Hannmann Machinery Systems for the last 20 years, and previously worked for Lockheed Martin Corporation, where he was a recipient of the Aegis Excellence Award, and the US Navy as a civilian engineer. He received a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Cincinnati and a Master's degree in business from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.

Ralph is survived by his wife of 30 years, Barbara, a stepson, Patrick McCormick, MD (Beverly) and their son Peter; his stepdaughter, Anne Marsico (nee McCormick) (Andrew). Also surviving are two sisters, Patricia Brown (Kent) of Oregon, Carol of Pittsburgh, and his Aunt, Agnes Barkley, of Pittsburgh.

Ralph was born in Long Island, NY, and was raised in Ohio. After college he traveled the world working as an engineer for the U.S. Navy, including assignments in Egypt on the Suez Canal Clearance Task Force.
