Roger K. Graham, 94, of Moorestown, New Jersey, passed away peacefully on December 20, 2023. Roger is survived by his wife of 73 years, Polly (nee Anderson), and his children, Dana and Tracey Graham.

Born on May 24, 1929 in New York City, Roger grew up in Meriden, CT. He graduated from The Choate School and from MIT before earning his Ph.D. in Chemistry from the University of Chicago. He had a notable 43-year career at Rohm & Haas, primarily in Bristol, PA.

Very active in the community, Roger had served as President and Treasurer of the Moorestown Y's Men's Club. He was also a Past President of the Resident Council at the Evergreens retirement community.

Roger was a long-time member of the First Presbyterian Church of Moorestown, where he enjoyed singing in the choir. His love of music was put to good use in support of the West Jersey Chamber Music Society.

Roger and Polly traveled extensively, visiting each of the continents except Antarctica. He left behind many beautiful photos of their travels. In his free time, Roger enjoyed listening to classical music, working on crossword puzzles, and rooting for the Phillies, 76ers, and Eagles.

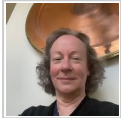

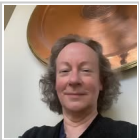

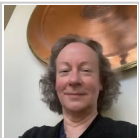
