“ I am sorry for the lateness of my message. I hope you can hear this Mrs. Moccia. My name is Ericka Stoor and I was in the Holy Cross High School graduating class of 1990. I am about to do my doctorate defense next week and I started reflecting on how I got here and my first and most powerful memory originates from you. I was blessed to be in your class my senior year - my first and only honors class. I was a fish out of water - and you knew that. While other students were talking about their acceptance to Yale, Harvard, and Princeton, I remained quiet - because I knew I would not be able to go to college and was embarrassed by the fact that I had no resources to go. I remember in our class, you asked us to write about our favorite poem/poet - I chose Andrew Marvell's "To My Coy Mistress". Many weeks passed after that assignment and I forgot all about it until you presented a full scholarship letter for Burlington County College in the Literature Department! I was going to college! You cemented my future and I will be forever grateful. I graduated from BCC with a pre-med major and a literature minor. From there I became an EMT, then a paramedic, and then a Physician Assistant specializing in Trauma and Acute Care Surgery for the last 20 years.
