Siegfried Hagemeyer, 87, of Moorestown, NJ passed away November 2, 2016 at his home after a brief illness.

He was born in Frankfort, Germany to the late Friedrich Hagemeyer and Frau Vollmer. He lived in Berlin Germany during WW II, and obtained a sponsor to come to America in 1958 becoming a US Citizen in 1962.
