Steven M. Hearn, Sr., aged 72, of Moorestown, passed away Oct. 8, 2024. Steve grew up in Moorestown and was a graduate of Moorestown High School, Class of 1970. While not tall in stature, Steve made up for it in personality. Steve's early life was not easy, but those hardships made him into the man he became. Steven was a fierce defender of his friends, family, and community, notably through his service with the Relief Engine Fire Co. and Hose Fire Co., and later with the Moorestown Fire Police.

Steve dedicated 28 years of his life working at UPS in Lawnside, NJ, to provide a better life for his family than he was afforded as a child. While those years took a toll on him physically, he always put that aside as soon as he came home. He is survived by his loving wife of 50 years, Stella (nee Heisler); his sons, Steven M. Hearn Jr. and Scott Hearn (Caroline); his cherished grandchildren, Hayward and Lillian; and his dog Jasper.

The impact Steve had on his friends and family was immense and his memory will live on through the appropriate and sometimes inappropriate stories, those he left behind will continue to share until they can meet him again.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held 11:30 am on Tuesday Oct. 15th at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, 42 W. Main St., Moorestown, NJ, Viewing preceding the service from 10:30 to 10:45 am at the church.
