On January 12th, 2014, at 95, Virginia Ashworth Denton passed away after a long fight with Parkinson's disease. She was born in Newark, NJ, in 1918, lived on Long Beach Island during the Depression, and graduated from Irvington High School in 1936, winning the English prize. She went on to become a cost accountant and literary devotee.

She was pre-deceased by her husband of 64 years, Richard Arthur Denton. Together they started the scientific company, Denton Vacuum, now in Moorestown. She is survived by her three children: Patricia Denton Saleh of Santa Barbara, CA; Judith Denton Jones of Hope, ME; and Peter Richard Denton of Moorestown. Virginia has 6 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Virginia, "GG," wrote throughout her life: poetry, fiction, descriptions of the many travels she and her husband took, essays about the Pine Barrens where they lived for 40 years.

A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, January 18th from 3 to 4 pm at the Trinity Presbyterian Church – 499 Marlton Pike East (route 70), Cherry Hill, NJ 08034.
